Terms and Conditions

- The vineyard aisles are of a certain size so the majority of available tables are of 2 on a first come first served basis.
- Additional dates may be added dependant on demand/weather.
- We have tried to minimise your contact with our staff; therefore, all items are disposable, and your tables will be cleared after departure.
- Pre-payment is required **ONLINE** in advance.
- Contactless payments only on the day for additional beverages.
- Disposables, sanitisation stations, one-way system and a designated tables and service area will be in place

Weather

- In the event of adverse weather and the event postponed, we will transfer your booking to another date.
- We will endeavour to give sufficient notice of postponement via email as the event cannot be moved indoors due to government restrictions.
- The vineyard is set within a walled garden, so please stay **SUN SAFE**.

- Please be aware the Vineyard is on uneven ground consisting of grass and gravel.
